**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Peace Vanguard is a high-profile program which provides individual, collective and recurrent training to the Republic of Singapore Air force to facilitate a fully mission capable 127<sup>th</sup> Squadron. Selectee must be able to work in a multi-cultural environment, have excellent communication skills. Selectee will be required to perform frequent periods of TDY.**

**INITIAL ENTRY SELECTION CRITERIA**

1. Soldiers selected must meet medical standards prescribed by AR 40-501 chapter 2 or 4, as appropriate. Individuals will submit a results from a qualified physical and AIDS test completed within the last year. Soldiers must meet the physical requirements of AR 600-9. Females will be tested for pregnancy within 30 days prior to initial entry on active duty.
2. Soldiers must possess a secret security clearance commensurate with their duty position. If required, an investigation will be initiated for a security clearance. Unfavorable results will be cause for immediate separation.
3. Soldiers selected for EAD must be eligible to complete a minimum of 3 years on EAD military status prior to completing 18 years of active federal service AND/OR the date of mandatory removal. An approved wavier will negate these requirements.
4. Soldiers selected for a Peace Vanguard EAD tour will not be reassigned until completion of the EAD tour; except in the event of mobilization, or removal for cause.
5. Acceptance of this EAD position terminates current Title 10, Title 32 and ARNG Technician service. Current Arizona ARNG soldiers (Title 32 or Technician) selected for Peace Vanguard EAD assignments will be allowed reentry into the AZ ARNG under their status prior to departure.

6. Peace Vanguard is an Equal Opportunity employer. Selection for this will be based on merit, fitness, capability, and potential, to ensure fair treatment of all soldiers.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION**

1. Assignment to EAD is covered IAW AR 135-200, and AR 135-210. As a minimum, the following items will be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible.

- a. DA Form 160-R – Application for Active Duty
- b. SF 88 & 93
- c. DA Form 5500-R (Body Fat Worksheet, if applicable)
- d. Certified Copy of DA Form 2-1 or equivalent
- e. DA Form 705 (Army Physical Fitness Test Score Sheet)
- f. Latest five evaluation reports (OER/NCOERs)
- g. DA Form 759 if applying for an aviation position
- h. Current Military Photo (if interviewing by telephone)

2. Successful applicants are required to submit a DA Form 1058-R.

3. Applications must be received at the address and closing date/time shown on the front side of this announcement. Positions identified as remaining opened until filled, will not have a close date/time, and will be filled by the first qualified applicant. 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### **BRIEF DUTY DESCRIPTION** **SUPPLY SPECIALIST**

The USAFTD supply specialist performs duties involving request, receipt, storage, issue, accountability, and preservation of individual, organizational, installation, and expendable supplies and equipment. Receives, inspects, inventories, loads, unloads, segregates, stores, issues, delivers and turns in equipment. Prepares supply documents. Maintains automated and manual supply systems for accounting of organizational supplies. Issues and receives small arms. Secures and controls weapons and ammunition in security areas. Responsible for dispatch, accounting & maintenance of GSA vehicles. Coordinates supply activities with Logistics Officer and Contract personnel. Experience with IMPAC credit card, HAZMAT and forklift operation is desired. Establishes and maintains formal and informal communication with SSAs, maintenance, transportation and training activities. A working knowledge of personal computers, word processing, spreadsheets and data bases is required. Performs all other duties as assigned in support of the training mission.
