ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Peace Vanguard is a high-profile FMS program which provides individual, collective and recurrent training to the Republic of Singapore Air Force to facilitate a fully mission capable AH-64D Apache Squadron. Selectee must be able to work in a multi-cultural environment, have excellent communication, organizational, prioritization, management, and leadership skills. Selectee will be required to perform frequent periods of TDY.

INITIAL ENTRY SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Soldiers selected must meet medical standards prescribed by AR 40-501 chapter 2 or 4, as appropriate. Individuals will submit a results from a qualified physical and AIDS test completed within the last year. Soldiers must meet the physical requirements of AR 600-9. Females will be tested for pregnancy within 30 days prior to initial entry on active duty.
2. Soldiers must possess a secret security clearance commensurate with their duty position. If required, an investigation will be initiated for a security clearance. Unfavorable results will be cause for immediate separation.
3. Soldiers selected for EAD must be eligible to complete a minimum of 3 years on EAD military status prior to completing 18 years of active federal service AND/OR the date of mandatory removal. An approved wavier will negate these requirements.
4. Soldiers selected for a Peace Vanguard EAD tour will not be reassigned until completion of the EAD tour; except in the event of active duty mobilization, or removal for cause.
5. Acceptance of this EAD position terminates current Title 10, Title 32 and ARNG Technician service. Current Arizona ARNG soldiers (Title 32 or Technician) selected for Peace Vanguard EAD assignments will be allowed reentry into the AZ ARNG under their status prior to departure.

6. Peace Vanguard is an Equal Opportunity employer. Selection for this will be based on merit, fitness, capability, and potential, to ensure fair treatment of all soldiers.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

1. Assignment to EAD is covered IAW AR 135-200, and AR 135-210. As a minimum, the following items will be submitted. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible.

- b. SF 88 & 93
- c. DA Form 5500-R (Body Fat Worksheet, if applicable)
- d. Certified Copy of DA Form 2-1 or equivalent
- e. DA Form 705 (Army Physical Fitness Test Score Sheet)
- f. Latest five evaluation reports (OER/NCOERs)
- g. DA Form 759 if applying for an aviation position
- h. Current Military Photo (if interviewing by telephone)

2. Successful applicants are required to submit a DA Form 1058-R.

3. Applications must be received at the address and closing date/time shown on the front side of this announcement. BRIEF DUTY DESCRIPTION **AVIATION OPERATIONS NCO**

Provides tactical and technical expertise to subordinates, superiors and RSAF members in aviation operations. Plans, coordinates and supervises activities pertaining to organization, training, and combat operations for US & RSAF personnel (includes implementing aircraft gunnery operations and small arms ranges). Coordinates implementation of operations, training programs and communications activities. Submits USAFTD members for training using ATRRS, tracks and projects future training needs & coordinates orders. Performs all duties as principal NCO in USAFTD. Identifies soldiers requiring positions associated with the design, development, testing, management, standardization, and evaluation of instructional systems using the HQDA approved systems approach to training method. Must be familiar with tactical air operations, close-air support, tactical airlift and tactical air reconnaissance in support of joint operations using ground and tactical air units. Must have experience in AH-64 FARP operations and projecting weapon and munitions for small arms qualification using STRAC.
